Dear Ms Cristian

I refer to your facsimile received on 4 and 10 December 2008 concerning Enforcement Orders 268490746 and 263236950.

We advised you in our correspondence dated 1 December 2008 that a local court was the appropriate forum for consideration of the legal matters you raised. If you wished to take up this option to have the issues heard in court before a magistrate, you were advised to lodge an annulment application for each enforcement order, accompanied by a \$50 application fee. Alternatively you were given the option to pay the matters in full, or apply to repay the outstanding amounts by instalments on a Time to Pay (TTP) order.

Unfortunately an error was made on the letter of 1 December 2008, where the due date for you to take action was incorrectly recorded as 14 January 2008 instead of 14 January 2009. This extension of time was not communicated to the NSW Sheriff's Office. NSW Sheriff's Office officers from the NSW Sheriff attended your property to execute a property seizure order on 18 December 2008.

Through a phone call to the attending police officer I advised the NSW Sheriff's Office to defer any seizure of goods until 14 January 2009. I apologise for any confusion this may have caused you.

I have again reviewed your correspondence and regret to advise you that your options to resolve these matters are unchanged. By 14 January 2009 you must either:

- Submit an annulment application if you wish to dispute the outstanding enforcement orders. Please note a \$50 fee must accompany each application
- Pay the total amount due on the enclosed enforcement orders.
- If you are unable to pay in full, you can apply to pay these enforcement orders by instalments. Please complete the enclosed application for Time to Pay (TTP) and return it to the address shown.

If you do not take up any of the options listed above by 14 January 2009, the property seizure order will be enforced and the NSW Sheriff's Office will be directed to attend your property to seize goods to the value of the enforcement order.
